A country of fertile plains, high mountains and deserts, it is home to diverse ethnic and religious groups, including Kurds, Armenians, Assyrians, Christians, Druze, Alawite Shia and Arab Sunnis. Over 6.7 million are refugees.

Since 2011 political power, long held by a small mainly Alawite elite, has been contested in a bitter civil conflict that turned into a complex war involving regional and international powers. Turkey, Russia, the USA and Iran.

Over 570 000 people have died as a result of this war.

## **God Bless the People of Yemen**

Despite its ancient roots as the crossroads of Africa, the Middle East and Asia, the modern Republic of Yemen is a relatively new state.

It was created after South Yemen merged with the North in 1990, following years of strife, but tensions have never been far below the surface.

During the 2011 protests, President Ali Abdallah Saleh resigned.

In the ensuing turmoil, the Houthis seized much of the north and west of the country, while Saudi-led forces intervened to support the internationally-recognized government based in the south.

By 2015 Yemen had plunged into civil war and a grave humanitarian crisis.

After more than four years of war and a Saudi-led siege, almost 16 million Yemenis face "severe acute food insecurity" - this means one in two Yemenis doesn't have enough to eat.

Over 80 000 people have died, 21000 in this year.

## God Bless the People of Afghanistan.

Landlocked and mountainous, Afghanistan's economy and infrastructure are in ruins, and many of its people are refugees.

When civil war ended in 2001, Nato-led foreign combat troops had the main responsibility for maintaining security.

The internationally-recognised government set up following the adoption of a new constitution in 2004 has struggled to extend its authority beyond the capital and to forge national unity

The formal end of Nato's combat mission in December 2014 was followed by an upsurge in Taliban activity.

And just this week, Nine children were killed when a planted roadside bomb exploded as they walked to school in a northeastern province of Afghanistan.

2 million fatalities have occurred with 41 thousand in this past year.
